Note from President Eric

Dear Libertytown-Unionville Lions & Friends,

If you're reading this in early September, we're less than 10 days away from our **42nd year** of serving pizzas (and funnel cakes!) at The Great Frederick Fair. The theme of this year's Fair is "**The** Greatest Fair **Of All Time**," or **The GOAT**, and that theme couldn't be more appropriate for Libertytown-Unionville Lions Club (LULC) as we look to eclipse our previous records for volunteer participation and funds raised.

Last year, we had outstanding participation from fellow Lions, Leos and community members in accumulating 498 volunteer hours – 327 from LULC members and 171 from others – that kept our trailer running smoothly in the face of record crowds at the Fair. This year, we have signups accounting for 350 volunteer hours already, but that means we still need <u>at least</u> 150 more hours worth of signups in the next week to equal or exceed what we achieved before. Not signed up yet? I can help with that...

One of our primary functions is to raise funds that can be reinvested within our community, so having a profitable Fair experience plays a huge role in meeting our budgeted Goals for the year. While 2022 was our most profitable year at the Fair (\$10,469), we set sales records in 2023 (\$17,097) that we plan to exceed in 2024. Again, to do this, we need to be well-staffed to handle the inevitable lines when the Fair gets crowded, or to stay late sometimes when we can earn some extra dollars.

And I would be remiss if I didn't mention that a great "stretch goal" would be to use the Fair experience as a chance to recruit some potential new Lions to our club and our cause. Remember to be patient when we train any new volunteers, remember to be grateful and thank them (and everyone involved) for their time, and most importantly, remember that their overall experience might be the deciding factor as they learn more about the Lions mission and whether or not it interests them. As I've mentioned previously, I wouldn't be a Lions member without first volunteering several years at the Fair and getting to know my fellow (and future) LULC comrades.
